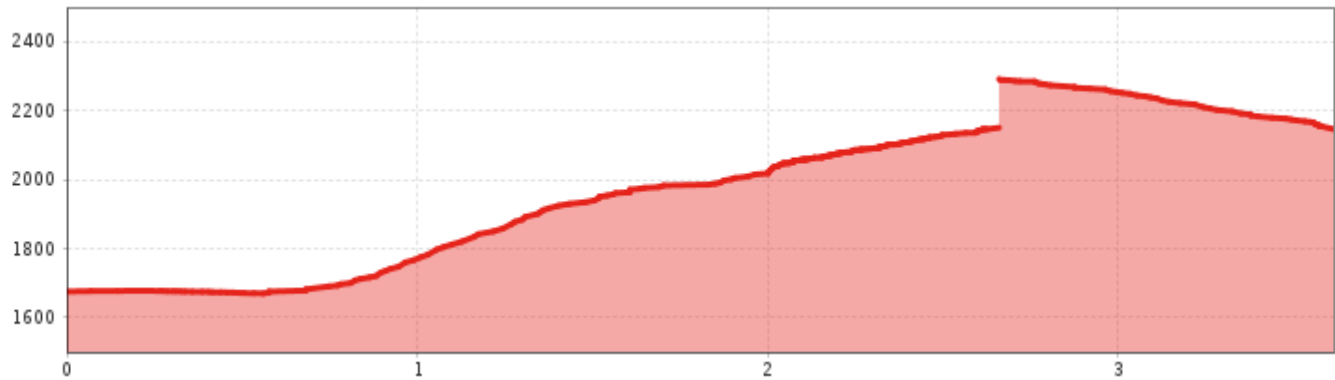

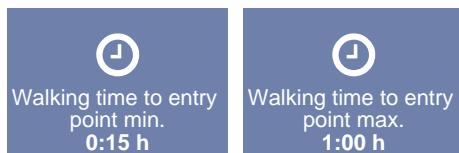

Approach

From the free car park in Mandarfen, the ascent is either via the panoramic trail that leads to the Riffelseehütte or you can use the cable car (Riffelseebahn), which is easy on your strength, and the ascent is from above via the trail through the Hirschtal valley.

Getting there

From the motorway exit A12 "IMST - Pitztal" follow the road towards the Pitztal Glacier for about 45 minutes. In Mandarfen (1 km before the Pitztal Glacier) you can park your car north of the Riffelseebahn cable car.

Description

The Hirschtal climbing garden is just a 15-minute walk downhill from the mountain station of the Riffelsee cable car. The 11 routes are of medium difficulty between 5c+ and 7b+. The incline of the rock face provides a wonderful view out of the valley to the hamlets of Tieflehn, Plangeroß and Weißwald.
